### **K-Limited Carrier's Candi Wolbert Named To National Tank Truck Carriers Safety and Security Council**

TOLEDO, Ohio, Sept. 30, 2015 – Candi Wolbert, director of safety and regulatory compliance with K-Limited Carrier, LTD, a nationally recognized liquid bulk carrier, has been appointed to serve as the Eastern Region Chair of the Safety and Security Council of the National Tank Truck Carriers (NTTC) association. She earned a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the University of Toledo, Toledo, Ohio.

"Candi brings a level of expertise that will be of great benefit to this group.
